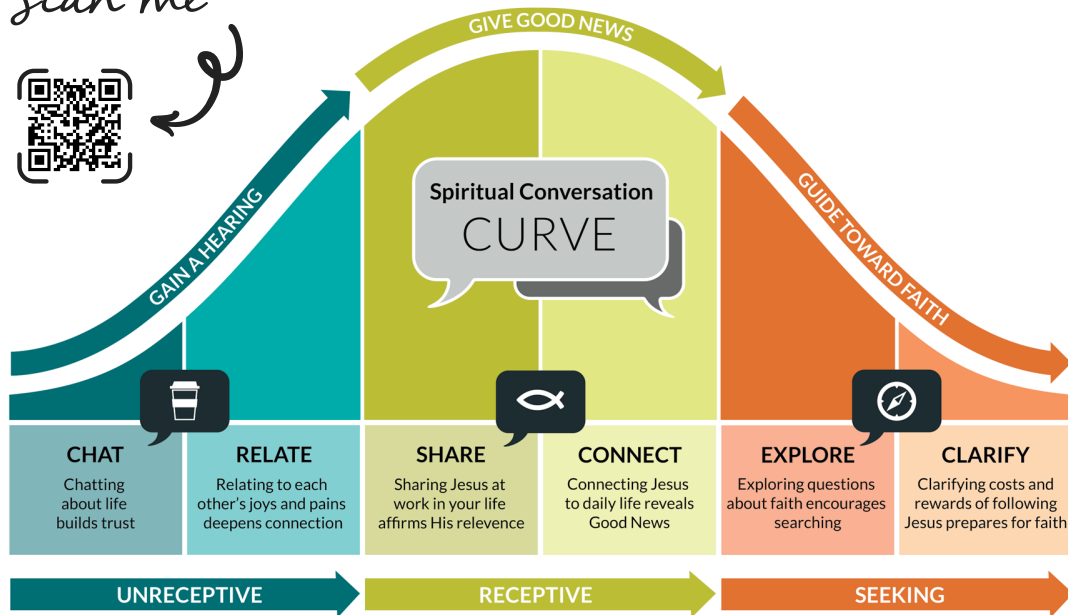
My Hopeful Neighbourhood Map
