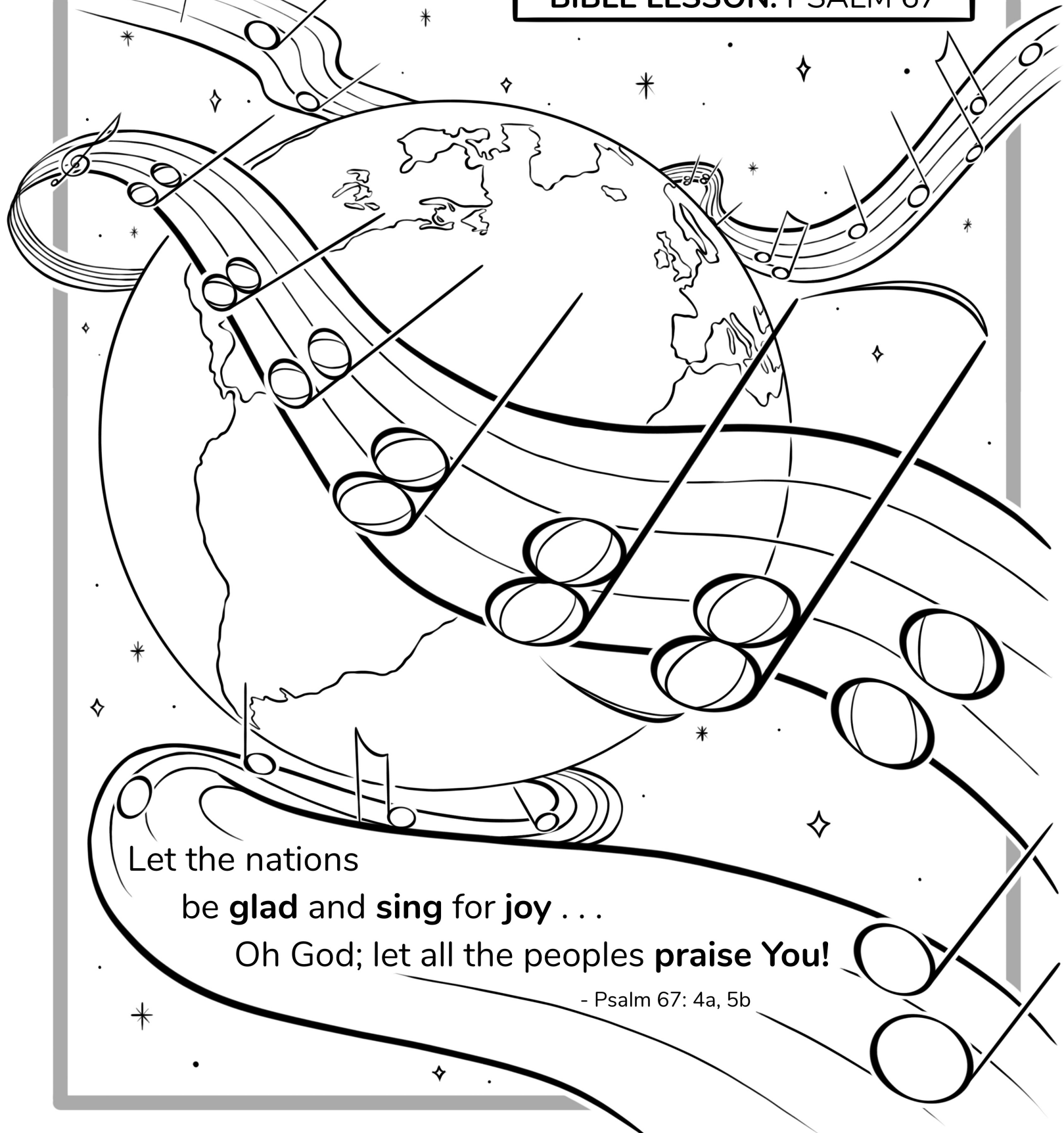




KIDS' LECTIONARY LEARNING
