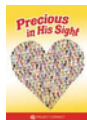
____Let's Be Disciples (6BE168)

Jesus' first disciples were ordinary people like you and me. He called and they followed. He taught and they listened and learned. We can all be His disciples and spread the Good News of Jesus.



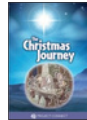
____The Bully (6BE151)
